COSMOSCOW FOUNDATION ANNOUNCES DETAILS OF COSMOSCOW 2019 NON-COMMERCIAL PROGRAMMING

- Artist of the Year MishMash art group
- Museum of the Year Moscow Museum of Modern Art

Cosmoscow Foundation for Contemporary Art announces details of the 7th Cosmoscow International Comtemporary Art Fair non-commercial programming. It will feature a number of art project specially commissioned for the Fair. They will include projects presented by Mish-Mash art group (Artist of the Year), Zarya CCA from Vladivostok (Institution of the Year), artist Maria Agureeva, the winner of the Ruinart Art Patronat grant, and by Moscow Museum of Modern Art (Museum of the Year). Credit Suisse Cosmoscow Prize for Young Artists will be awarded at the Fair for the fourth year in a row (in 2018 it was won by Asya Marakulina).

Margarita Pushkina, Founding Director of Cosmoscow, Founder of Cosmoscow Foundation: "I am very pleased that being established in 2017, today Cosmoscow Foundation has a life of its own. It successfully implements its own projects, supports artists and contributes to the completion of the fair's non-commercial program. The latter serves as a significant supplement to the main program allowing guests to get a broader picture of the most relevant processes taking place today in the world of contemporary art."

MishMash is an art group consisting of artists Misha Leykin and Masha Sumnina. Misha Leykin graduated from the Moscow Institute of Architecture in 1994, was a member of the Obledenenie Arkhitektorov group (1997–2001). Masha Sumnina graduated from the Institute of Printwork in 2001. The art of MishMash is distinguished by close study of art boundaries inherited from the representatives of Moscow romantic conceptualism movement. Their "peculiar lyricism and humanity of art" is fueled by trust in random elements and sympathy towards purely private material. "Our names combined together - mishmash - in many languages means jumble, confusion. We bring uncontrollable forces into our works - wind, mold, water, spectator, coincidence, found art, etc., exploring the relationship between chaos and order. We do not create a recognizable visual style, because the task, the concept — is essential, and for each we find its own material," — comment the artists. As part of Cosmoscow 2019, MishMash will present a total microspective of their work.



The Moscow Museum of Modern Art (MMOMA) is the first state Russian museum and was founded in 1999 by Zurab Tsereteli, President of the Russian Academy of Arts. His private collection of more than 2.000 works by important 20th century masters was the core of the Museum's permanent display and now it is one of the largest and most impressive collections of modern and contemporary Russian art, which continues to grow through acquisitions and donations. Today the Museum, with its six venues in the historic centre of the city, plays a vital part in the Moscow art scene. On of the buildings, MMOMA Education Center aims to become a platform for self-education, creative and social initiatives, academic research and will contribute the integration into the cultural life wide social groups. The Museum's permanent collection represents major stages in the formation and development of the avant-garde, especially in Russia. MMOMA's priorities are to promote young and emerging artists, bringing them into the contemporary artistic process, its own publishing program, laboratory expertise and to create inclusive projects. Today Museum develops special exhibition and education program for Russian cities. In 2019 MMOMA celebrates its 20th anniversary.



The Zarya Center for Contemporary Art first opened its doors in Vladivostok in 2013. Zarya CCA is located within the Zarya creative cluster, in the space of the former sewing factory that gave the site its name. Zarya CCA sees its mission in presenting the Primorye region with the best of contemporary art and culture from Russia and beyond, while also supporting artists and the local art community. Over the years, Zarya has implemented dozens of projects with the participation of the local artistic community, with a number of publications initiated; with the help of Zarya, works of Vladivostok artist toured around Russia and were shown in Moscow and St. Petersburg for the first time with some of them entering major collections (including works by Ilyas Zinatulin, Alexander Kiryakhno and Alexey Krutkin). At Cosmoscow 2019, projects presented by Zarya will be dedicated to those artists and art groups whose art became visible thanks to Zarya.

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The 7th Cosmoscow will take place at Moscow's Gostiny Dvor on September 6-8 with the Collectors' and VIP Preview on September 5, starting the international art calendar. Cosmoscow will be supported

by its long-standing partners: Main Partner Qatar Airways, Strategic Partner Credit Suisse, Automobile Partner Audi and Official Partner Ruinart. A detailed programme and a list of participated galleries will be announced later this summer.

Cosmoscow

Cosmoscow International Contemporary Art Fair was launched by art historian, young Russian artists' patron and collector Margarita Pushkina in 2010 and aims to bring together both Russian and international collectors, galleries and artists. Cosmoscow is Russia's only international art fair taking place every September with its own spot in the international art calendar.

The Foundation runs operations in three areas: execution of cultural projects, education, and replenishment of museum collections. The execution of cultural projects division includes such programmes as Artist of the Year and Institution of the Year. It also includes the Credit Suisse Cosmoscow Prize for Young Artists and the Ruinart Art Patronat grant. The educational division features Cosmoscow Talks and Cosmoscow Kids programmes along with the Cosmoscow Art Forum. As part of the replenishment of museum collections division, the Foundation acquires works of a contemporary artist to donate to a Russian museum selected as Museum of the Year. In 2017 works by Andrey Kuzkin were donated to the State Tretyakov Gallery, and in 2018 the collection of the Pushkin Museum of Fine Arts was enriched with video works by Taus Makhacheva. Systematically developing each direction, the Foundation forms a critical view of the art system's problems and contributes to their solution. It creates conditions for the professionalization of the environment and the visibility of Russian authors for the international community, thereby overcoming the gap between Russian and foreign contexts and forming a unified cultural field.
