





SECOND EDITION OF COSMOSCOW ART FORUM TO TAKE PLACE IN MOSCOW

The conference devoted to the international contemporary art market will take place at St. Regis Moscow Nikolskaya on Wednesday 29 June 2016



Moscow – The second edition of Cosmoscow Art Forum, a symposium devoted to the many aspects of the international contemporary art market, will take place at St. Regis Moscow Nikolskaya on Wednesday, 29 June 2016. The Art Forum is organized by Cosmoscow International Contemporary Art Fair, which will take place from 8 - 11 September 2016 at Gostiny Dvor, Moscow. The Fair is supported by strategic partner Credit Suisse and jewelry partner Carrera y Carrera.

This year Cosmoscow Art Forum coincides with the 5th Moscow International Biennale for Young Art, and the programme reflects this through inviting international and Russian young artists, gallery owners, collectors, art historians and art professionals to contribute to the talks and debates. Topics will cover the most current issues in relation to the contemporary art market in Russia.

Margarita Pushkina, Founding Director of Cosmoscow International Contemporary Art Fair says: "The level of interest among the expert community generated by the first edition of the Art Forum, has justified the need for making it an annual event, progressively involving the general public. This year the key topics of the Forum are young art and the process of introducing it into the international art market. We will discuss how the contemporary art market reference points are being formed, allowing better understanding of its operational aspects in Russia and fostering awareness about contemporary art in general. I am sure that participation in Cosmoscow Art Forum will benefit all art lovers and connoisseurs."

The first edition of the Art Forum took place on 9 June 2015 and attracted the attention of top Russian experts and international art professionals from major institutions and galleries. It was primarily devoted to current international contemporary art market trends, applicable to the local art scene in Moscow. The second edition will involve established art professionals, whose expertise and valuable advice will help navigate the vast and diverse landscape of contemporary art today. Besides their principal speeches, panelists will also provide audience with practical tips derived from their professional experience.

This year topics, introduced and debated by three main discussion panels, are:

- Contemporary art market reference points and main opinion makers;
- Young galleries and market positioning;
- Young collectors and art patrons the journey from collecting to supporting young artists.

The first discussion will be dedicated to the skills and knowledge that enable easier navigation through the complex contemporary art market. The second discussion will focus on numerous approaches towards aims and goals that are being set by new generation of art gallerists. The third discussion will explore the motivation that drives individuals to collect art. Moderated one-to-one Young Artists' Talks will enable the audience to discover young contemporary artists in an open and dynamic environment.

Cosmoscow International Contemporary Art Fair, aimed at bringing together both Russian and international collectors, galleries and artists, was launched by Russian collector and philanthropist Margarita Pushkina in 2010. Today Cosmoscow is the only international art fair in Russia and the CIS. Since 2014 it is an annual September event with its own place in an international art calendar. The latest edition of the fair took place at the Gostiny Dvor on September 11-13, 2016 representing over 30 local and international galleries and welcoming over 14,000 guests. Fair's collectors' preview was visited by 2500 people, with many of them participating in the "Off white" charity auction with the benefit to Naked Heart Foundation totaling €171,500.
