



The Cosmoscow International Contemporary Art Fair announces the participants of the 14th edition

108 contemporary art and design galleries will participate in the 14th edition of Cosmoscow, which will take place on September 4–6, 2026, on two floors of the Timiryazev Centre (6/1, Verkhnyaya Alley). Collectors and representatives of the art community will be the first to attend the fair at the Preview on September 3. Cosmoscow is supported by General Partner Sber: GigaChat and Sber Private Banking, Automobile Partner VOYAH, and companies including Hutton, MR, ědomo, Beluga, Tête de Cheval, Lamoda, Azbuka Vkusa, Konstantin Chaykin, Geltek, Mistral, Chupa-Chups, and Kids Program's partner Kangaroo.

The fair will occupy 17,010 square meters, spanning two floors and the courtyard of the Timiryazev Centre. Visitors will see 113 gallery booths, over 20 partner projects, and 9 non-profit cultural projects. The Cosmoscow Talks program will be held in the Lecture Hall and Media Forum. Kangaroo will prepare the Cosmoscow Kids area for young visitors, offering workshops, games, and creative activities.

Galleries' participation in the fair was confirmed following an expert selection process. During the open call, 190 applications were received, a record in the fair's history. Submissions, made through a personal account on the Cosmoscow website, included information about the artists, works, and booth concepts.

The 2026 Expert Committee:

Margarita Pushkina, founder of the Cosmoscw institutional platform; Elena Selina, co-founder of XL Gallery; Elvira Tarnogradskaya, founder of Syntax Gallery; and Valentin Dyakonov, curator and art critic.

The DESIGN section's Expert Committee:

Margarita Pushkina, founder of the Cosmoscw institutional platform; Maria Savostyanova, art historian; and Alena Sokolnikova, design historian, curator, and teacher.

Participating galleries will be divided into sections, each reflecting different contemporary art mediums and working models:

BASE: Galleries with their own exhibition space and proven experience in systematically working with artists.

FRAME: Galleries without a permanent space, and galleries with up to five years of experience.

EDITION: Galleries specializing in prints and multiples.

DIGITAL: Projects in digital technology, media art, and online platforms specializing in digital art sales.

DESIGN: Galleries and online platforms specializing in product design.

COMMUNITY: Projects aimed at developing infrastructure, education, and communication in contemporary art and increasing interest in collecting.

In 2026, 108 galleries will participate in the fair: 20 of them will be participating for the first time, 27 will represent the regional art scene, and 15 exhibitors will showcase works by international artists.

Guests will be able to see works by such prominent artists as Nikita Alekseev at the Iragui Gallery stand; video art by the Blue Soup group at the XL Gallery stand; Alina Pinsky Gallery will present works by Evgeny Muzalevsky; Jessica Gallery will feature works by Nestor Engelke; HLAM Gallery will present works by Ivan Gorshkov; ALTMANS GALLERY will offer collectors a lithograph by Marc Chagall, and сцена/szena will present a solo stand featuring works by Cosmoscow 2026 Artist of the Year Igor Samolet.

The fair will feature works by contemporary artists from various cities in Russia and around the world. Arka Gallery from Vladivostok will present works by Alexander Kiryakhno; Ufa's Miras Gallery will bring works by Rasikh Akhmetvaliev, co-founder of the Genghis Khan artist group, to Moscow; GSL will present works by Canadian designer Florence Provencher-Proulx; and at the Savour Gallery stand, visitors will see works by Japanese artist Taro Kamoda.

In the DESIGN section, KRASSKY Gallery will present works by Italian artist Vincenzo De Cotiis; works by Oswaldo Vigas from Venezuela will be on display at the RAFINAD Gallery stand, and at WE Gallery, guests will be able to see works by Oscar Niemeyer from Brazil.

This year, new galleries will join the fair. The Cabinet of Graphics will present works by Pasha Bumazhny; the TIHO Gallery stand will feature works by Alexander Volkov; Joy Gallery will present paintings by Adele Levitova; and Culture is participating for the first time, featuring works by Anna Slobozhanina.

The second floor will house the EDITION, DESIGN, and DIGITAL sections. In the edition graphics section, guests will see works by Viktor Pivovarov and Vladimir Nemukhin at the E.K. ArtBureau stand; ArtTube Editions will showcase works by Dmitry Kavka, while the SUBSTATION booth will feature works by Vladimir Abikh. In the DESIGN section, HERITAGE will showcase a table by Song Tao; 3L GALLERY will feature pieces by Indian designers Nitush-Aroosh; Tirage Unique will feature pieces by Pierre Jeanneret; and A-HOUSE will feature works by Dasha Cheva. Digital Art: MESS {XR Lab} will present works by Alexander Pogrebnyak and Stepan Tereshchenko.

Cosmoscow will also be organizing a parallel program at various locations across Moscow, featuring lectures, exhibitions, exclusive tours, and other events.

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Alongside Cosmoscow, the seventh edition of the blazar satellite fair will be held from September 17 to 20 at the OPUS Clubhouse (1, Derbenevskaya St). A preview of the fair for collectors and the art community will take place on September 16. The fair will bring together not only galleries but also early-career artists, independent artists, designers, and architectural firms in the art and design sections, as well as educational institutions and initiatives in the field of contemporary art.
